

About the event

Women in Mathematics Day is celebrated in memory of Maryam Mirzakhani, a distinguished Iranian mathematician recognized for her groundbreaking research in Teichmüller theory, hyperbolic geometry, ergodic theory, and symplectic geometry. She was the first woman to be awarded the Fields Medal in 2014, and her contributions greatly enhanced the understanding of complex curved surfaces. Held on her birthday, May 12, this day honors the significant impact of women in mathematics and aims to inspire future female mathematicians. It emphasizes the importance of diversity and inclusion within the mathematical community, continuing Mirzakhani's legacy.
